### **EMERGENCY SERVICES**

In 2009, Denver Rescue Mission

- Served 691,502 meals.
- Fed 13,086 people through food boxes.
- Provided 168,676 nights of shelter.
- Distributed 196 tons of clothing.
- Supplied 822 families with furniture.
- Provided 13,320 Client Service visits.
- Received 3,900 visits in the Health Clinic.

### **PROGRAMS AND EDUCATION**

In 2009, at the Denver Rescue Mission

- Sixty-one men and women graduated from the New Life Program.
- Twenty-seven men and women earned their GEDs.
- Eighty-five residents went on to higher education.

### **FAMILY SERVICES**

In 2009, DRM helped a total of 256 families into permanent housing.

- Two hundred twelve families and seniors moved into permanent housing through FSHI (Family and Senior Homeless Initiative) and FRS (Family Refugee Services).
- Forty-four STAR THP (STAR Transitional Housing Program) households at The Crossing found sustainable permanent housing.
- Eighty-seven congregations and service organizations mentored homeless families through FSHI (Family and Senior Homeless Initiative).

### **VOLUNTEERS**

- In 2009, volunteers donated 131,905 hours of time. That's equivalent to the work of 66 full-time employees!
- In addition, forty-two medical professionals volunteered at the clinic and eighty-five interns came to the mission to learn how to work with the homeless.
