Every night, the Denver Rescue Mission shelters up to **904** men, women and children in its emergency shelter and transitional living facilities.

CAPACITY

THE CROSSING

- 131** **New Life Program**
- 28** **Respite Guests** (14 rooms at 2 people per room can house 24 men and 4 women)
- + **342** **STAR Transitional Housing Program** (90 rooms)
- 501** The Crossing, at capacity, can house **501** men, women, and children each night.

LAWRENCE STREET SHELTER

- 200** **Emergency shelter beds.** (40 of these beds are used for New Life Program candidates).
- + **100** **Overflow beds** during inclement weather
- 300** The Lawrence Street Shelter can house up to **300** men each night.

CHAMPA HOUSE

- 9** **Mothers**
- + **22** **Children**
- 31** At capacity, Champa House can provide **9 mothers and 22 children** transitional living apartments and a long-term rehabilitation program.

HARVEST FARM

- 72** **Men** in the New Life Program. One goal of the Changing Lives Capital Campaign is to expand the NLP at Harvest Farm to 100 men.
